

Saturday, August 23 – English Paper Piecing (1:00pm–2:00pm)

Textile artist Terry Myra demonstrates the beautiful art of English paper piecing. Discover the techniques and history behind this traditional craft—and leave inspired to start your own project!

Saturday, August 30 – Archaeology for Kids (1:00pm–2:00pm)

Dig into the past! Kids will handle real tools, learn what archaeologists do, and participate in a mock dig. Special guest Michaela Kraft will share stories from an actual excavation she joined in Jordan.
